Installing

Download and run the 'Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0.1' installation file 'setup.exe'. An MSI is available from support by contacting support@exclaimer.com.

Uninstalling

Uninstall can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' or MSI for the currently installed version of 'Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0' or via 'Add/Remove Programs' in Windows 2003 and Windows XP or 'Programs and Features' in Windows 2008, Windows 2012, Windows Vista, Windows 7 and Windows 8.

The uninstall process will not lose any of your configuration or settings. However as a backup precaution you may wish to export your configuration.

Export Steps

- 1. Open the Exclaimer Console
- 2. Select the 'Exclaimer' node
- 3. Open the 'Action' menu
- 4. Select 'Export Configuration...'
- 5. Select a location and filename for the export
- 6. Press Save

This will export all your settings including all your templates and licensing data.

Upgrading

Upgrading from Signature Manager 2.0 to Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0.0 can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' which will perform an in-place upgrade.

Fixed Issues

- Image path not correctly set to the UNC of an image when using Remote Deployment.
- If a {Conditional Field} is inside a {List of Fields} its values are lost when going back to the editor.
- When pasting an image from a template from a previous version, the SRC path in Properties is incorrect.
- {Rotating Banner Ad} "Filter" property is respected in Preview, but not in the Policy Tester or generated signatures.
- Exception thrown when trying to edit a template that contains an invalid path to an image.
- Images with read only attribute cause high CPU usage for the 'Exclaimer Signature Manager Outlook Edition Configuration Service'.
- Smart Table Text Properties not taking effect.
- Exception thrown when attempting to set the Webpage field to a static URL in a contact block.

- Exception thrown when saving a template that has "Other AD fields" in a "Conditional Field".
- Installation fails when Windows Management Framework is not installed.
- Composite fields not displayed correctly in Design view after upgrading from version 2.0.
- Exception thrown when opening an upgraded template that was originally created in Auto Responder version 1.0 where the template contains Sender or Recipient AD fields
- Characters with umlauts or accents are not displayed correctly in Custom Hyperlink in Rich Text.
- Unable to close error dialog when previewing plain text templates when a file referenced in the template cannot be found.
- You cannot drag and drop template fields onto an HTML template from the fields menu on the left of the template editor.
- Field formatting is not applied for fields in the "Text to display" field of a custom hyperlink in an RTF template.

Known Issues

- Unable to determine Share and Security permissions on a DFS namespace share running in Windows Server 2008 mode.
- Security permissions are not applied correctly if the Deployment share is on a DFS namespace on Server 2008 but running in 2000 mode.
